- PT only to eval and treat: 3x/week for 2 weeks
- WB Status on THA and TKA: WBAT unless otherwise specified
- DVT Prophylaxis: ASA 81 mg BID starting POD 1 for 3-4 weeks
- TED hose to be worn on BLE until 1st post op visit. Will be determined at that time if should wear longer.
 - Thigh high hose for knees
 - Knee high hose for hips
- **No wound care needed.** No dressing changes by HH agency. Patient will be sent home with Aquacel Surgical dressing in place. Patient will have information and directions for care of dressing.
- Silver dressing will remain in place and will be removed in 10-14 days by staff at Dr. Schrayer's office during follow up. (Nursing Education hand out with information to call Dr. Schrayer's office in case of excessive drainage. Patient MUST notify Surgeon if there is excessive drainage.)
- Incision with suture/staple closing (under dressing) MUST be covered for showering. *Pt educated on use of gallon size Ziploc baggie and medipore tape*.
- If Staples present, removal will be on follow up visit at surgeon office.
- SN not ordered or necessary for initial assessment or follow up.
 - o If PT notes possible SN need, please contact surgeon's office for order.
- For constipation issues: Patient has been instructed in pre-op class, by surgeon and nursing education on discharge to start Colace day of DC and add Miralax, Dulcolax or Milk of Mag OTC if problems continue.
